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# Basil Pesto

Ingredients:
2 cloves garlic
2 cups fresh basil leaves, packed
3 tablespoons pecans
Salt and pepper, to taste
½ cup extra virgin olive oil
½ cup freshly grated Parmesan
Reggiano cheese
1 tbsp lemon juice

In a food processor, add garlic, basil and pecans; pulse until combined. While the processor is running, slowly pour oil into the opening at the top. Puree until all ingredients are mixed well. Add salt, pepper, lemon juice and Parmesan cheese. Mix until combined. If mixture is thick add a little more olive oil until desired consistency is reached.

Pesto is delicious as a pasta sauce, a base for pizza or a marinade for chicken and shrimp.
